

## Changes to Immunization Laws affecting Pre-k 4 students entering Kindergarten School Year 2009-10

### Changes

to Texas State Law, Title 25 Health Services, Section 97.61 – 97.77 of the Texas Administrative Code for the 2009-2010 School Year.

### Beginning School Year (SY) 2009-10:

1. Varicella Vaccine (chickenpox)
  - a. 2 dose requirement for kindergarten entry
2. MMR Vaccine
  - a. 2 dose requirement of MMR vaccine for kindergarten entry
3. Hepatitis A Vaccine
  - a. 2 dose requirement for kindergarten entry statewide

## Changes to Immunization Laws affecting 6th grade students entering 7th grade School Year 2009-10

### Changes

to Texas State Law, Title 25 Health Services, Section 97.61 – 97.77 of the Texas Administrative Code for the 2009-2010 School Year.

### Beginning School Year (SY) 2009-10:

1. Meningococcal Vaccine (MCV4)
  - a. requirement for 7th grade entry
2. Varicella Vaccine (chickenpox)
  - a. 2 dose requirement for 7th grade entry
3. Tdap Vaccine
  - a. a booster dose requirement for Tdap for 7th grade entry
