1. Student Member-Newest member, Adriana Osuna, Class of 2012.
2. State Level School Health Policies-Marlene White distributed copies of the most recent state level health polices to the members of the SHAC for overall review of the requirements. Donna Juarez suggested using the established network to determined if there is a more current document available.
3. Campus Health TEKS Survey Results-Shirley Hooker presented the SHAC with the results of the online campus surveys intended to help identify which health TEKS are already being taught in the classrooms.
